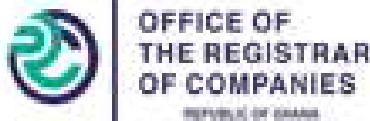

## HIGHLIGHTS OF KEY ACTIVITIES FROM THE 12 MONTHS

We take this opportunity to highlight some key inflections and activities for the last 12 months:  
IFC/ World Bank Train-the-Trainer Workshop:

**This workshop was held from 24th October to 28th October 2022:** The purpose of the event was to support institutional building by training Insolvency Practitioners; Office of the Registrar of Companies (ORC); Bankers; and the Judiciary on the CIRA Act.

**GARIA/AMCHAM/ORC Joint Information Workshop:** Over 100 people attended this event. The purpose of the event was to build capacity and sensitize companies on the new regulatory environment and operations of the ORC.

**Induction of the 2nd Cohort of licensed Insolvency Practitioners:** We successfully held the induction ceremony for the 2nd Cohort of 154 licensed Insolvency Practitioners on 1 March 2023. The ceremony received extensive news coverage. The Chairperson of the occasion was Honorary Council Member and Chairperson GARIA Trust Fund Her Ladyship Justice Sophia Akuffo.

**Advocacy for the Passage of the Chartered Institute of Restructuring and Insolvency Practitioners Bill:** A draft Bill has been finalized with the assistance from the Office of the Attorney-General and submitted to Cabinet for approval. In the course of its finalization, we successfully organized two Stakeholder Workshops to review and consolidate stakeholder views.



## HIGHLIGHTS OF KEY ACTIVITIES FROM THE 12 MONTHS

INSOL International is a world-wide federation of national associations of accountants and lawyers who specialise in turnaround and insolvency. There are currently over 44 Member Associations with over 10,500 professionals participating as members of INSOL International. Individuals who are not members of a member association join as individual members. INSOL International exists to support its members wherever they may be and in whatever role they perform in the restructuring and insolvency profession.

In the past year, GARIA has actively represented Ghana at INSOL engagements. In particular, at the INSOL Africa Round Table (ART) – Kigali, Rwanda where discussion on a number of matters regarding judicial practices extant in efficient resolution environments amongst others: specialized insolvency courts; time-bound court practice and procedures for insolvency cases; specialized corporate insolvency judges; structured training programs for insolvency judges; and court insolvency expert advisory panel.

This month's INSOL Tokyo Conference is to be held from 11 September 2023 to 13 September 2023. The Conference aims to focus on, amongst others: new regulatory framework set out in the Model Law on the Recognition and Enforcement of Insolvency Related Judgments; key drivers generating distressed and special situation opportunities; key difficulties that impede successful restructuring; and digitalization. GARIA is to be represented by the President of Governing Council, Felix Addo.

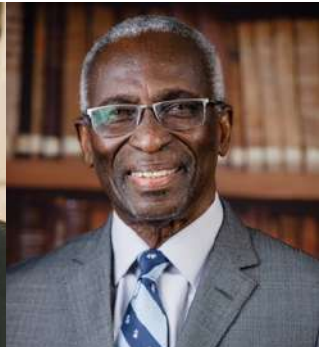

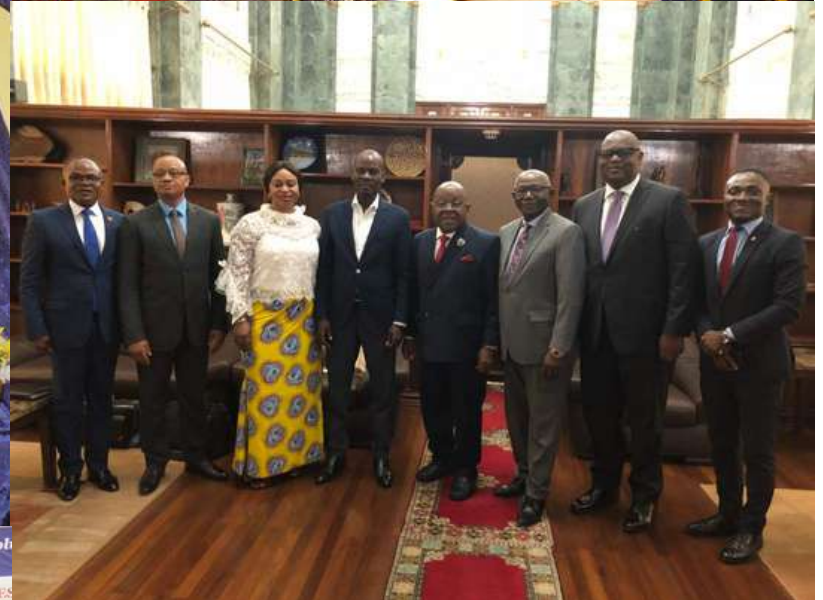
