

The decision to adopt Universal Trusted Credentials (UTC) is a global effort by the United Nations Development (UNDP), in partnership with the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS), to improve access to financing for MSMEs. This is achieved by proposing a framework for assessing an MSME's creditworthiness based on traditional and alternative data sets. This approach not only provides MSMEs with the tools to demonstrate their creditworthiness, but also fosters an environment that promotes their long-term sustainability and growth.


